Saturday, Oct. 16 2010 (blow day Sunday, Oct 17)**No Trailing During Tournament Hours.****Entry Fee – \$225.00 per team** (which includes entry for “Big Walleye” contest.)**Field Limit – 65 teams.** (One team per boat. Team capacity 2-6 anglers.) 60 teams will be considered a full pay-out field.

Please Note: State rod laws must be followed therefore

- 2 person teams are limited to a Maximum of 4 rods in the water.
- 3-6 person teams are limited to a Maximum of 6 rods in the water.

This Is An Open Communication Event. Radio, Phone, Text, Internet, etc. are all open as we want all teams to do well.**Tournament boundaries are limited to the OHIO waters of Lake Erie. Trolling, Drifting, & Casting are all accepted methods of fishing.****Registration - Online only!**Opens at 10am **Weds, Sept 8, 2010** www.fishhuronohio.com

Payment is accepted online only. (Visa, MC, Amex, Discover, Paypal) (\$5 online processing fee per registration). Registrations will be accepted until the field is full. Online registration will close at **NOON Friday, Oct. 15.** Upon Availability - Registrations after **NOON Friday, Oct. 15** will be accepted in **Cash Only** at The Huron Boat Basin. **Registration is non refundable but transferable with tournament director notification and approval.** **Fish Huron Ohio or the tournament director, has the right of entry refusal or expulsion for any reason.**

Friday, Oct. 15. All teams must have at least one member **check-in** between **6:30-7pm** at the Huron Boat Basin for a registration packet and **rules meeting at 7pm Sharp.** **There will be a Pre-Tournament Party (Location TBA) after the rules meeting with food provided (cash bar available).**

Boat Inspections

Begin Saturday, Oct. 16 at 7:15am in the water at the Huron Boat Basin at available open docks or along the West Wall of the Huron River. Have all storage compartments, coolers, and livewells open for inspection. This is **NOT** a safety inspection. All boat owners are responsible to have the legally required safety gear on board and each boat owner is responsible for the safety of their crew and equipment.

After your boat has been inspected you will receive a “CHIP”. You will need to bring it to the registration table in order to get your boat number. The sheet with your boat number will also contain detailed instructions for the take-off, check-in, and weigh-in procedures.

Teams will line-up in boat number order beginning at **8:10am** following the instructions given over **VHF radio channel 17** idling out the river.

Take-Off

Will be in boat registration order. You can take off once your boat number has been called. Teams must depart and return to the designated location at The Huron Boat Basin by water.

Flight 1 Take-Off begins 8:30am Flight 2 Take-Off begins 8:50am**Check-In Procedure**

Teams must show their boat number to the check-in person located at the designated location on the West Wall of the Huron River immediately North of the Boat Basin. This location will be pointed out in the morning and clearly marked. **Any team not SOUTH of the check-in point will be considered LATE and will not have their fish weighed.**

Flight 1 Check-In 3:30pm Flight 2 Check-In 3:50pm**Weigh-In**

Opens at 3:15pm and remains open for all checked-in teams.

- **Sort Your Fish Prior To Coming To The Weigh-In Area.**
- **Do Not Bring More Than 5 Walleye To The Weigh-In Station.**
Teams That Do Not Follow These Instructions Will Subsequently Not Have Their Fish Weighed And Will Therein Be Forfeited.

Each team will select **ONE Walleye** to have measured for **WEIGHT.** The **WEIGHT** of the single fish will determine the winner of the “**Big Walleye**” contest which will pay first and second place.

Each team must have one Walleye Weighed.**Tournament Finish**

Total Weight of 5 Walleye per team. It is the responsibility of the team to select the 5 fish to be weighed. The Weight of the heaviest Walleye measured per team will be used in the event of a placement weight tie.
